How do I reserve a bed once I receive my acceptance letter? Request a family member mail a money order for first month guest fee or have them make the payment on-line by visiting our website. Checks can be mailed from inmate accounts. A bed will also be reserved for those approved through Transitional Funding.

What should I do once released? Call our main office 208-898-4668 for your home address and to set up a time to meet your manager.

Is Rising Sun a faith based program? No, but we encourage you to work a spiritual program where you feel comfortable.

Are there time restrictions to remain in housing? No. Residents may stay as long as housing is needed.

What items can I bring with me? Clothing, toiletries, twin size bedding, towels, food, bike/vehicle, phone, tablet/laptop.

Can I smoke cigarettes or vape? Yes, but only in outside designated areas.

Are overnight and weekend passes available? Yes, as long as you receive permission from probation and parole.

Will I have to share a bedroom? Yes. There are two single beds in each bedroom.

Are visitors allowed in housing? No. This is to help secure the personal property of all residents.

Will there be additional fees charged? No. Cleaning supplies, laundry soap, utilities, and drug testing are provided.

Are homes equipped with tv, wifi and phone? Yes
